# **GAC Update: Educating Congress About 1031s.**

In 2023, FEA has continued its efforts to educate members of Congress about the economic benefits of Section 1031.

Since President Biden announced in March that his budget proposal would again include a \$500,000 cap on Section 1031, FEA members have participated in more 70 in-person Hill visits, generated more than 600 letters to Congress, and continued to regularly host congressional fundraising events through the FEA 1031 PAC.

So far this year, the PAC has sponsored 14 events with members of Congress. The events are often virtual and allow for FEA members from across the country to participate. During the meetings, participants share data from FEA's economic studies and discuss the benefits of Section 1031 exchanges.

## **FEA 1031 PAC: Upcoming Fundraisers**



The FEA 1031 PAC contributes to members of Congress of both political parties and is funded by eligible individual employees.

To become eligible, individuals must be employed by FEA member companies that have filed a Permission to Solicit form. A Permission to Solicit form is required by the Federal Election Commission before FEA can solicit eligible employees of member companies. Member companies are only permitted to grant one trade association permission to solicit their employees per calendar year.
